Easton Emergency Medical Services and the Easton Police Department will be offering training to prevent the potentially fatal effects of an opioid overdose.

FREE Narcan kits will be distributed at the end of the training to the first 20 registrants (***one per family***), courtesy of Silver Hill Hospital.

There will also be a mobile pharmacist on hand from Unity Pharmacy to help answer questions.
